Announcement by Chiang Mai University
Application for Admission to the International Undergraduate Programs
for the 2017 Academic Year for the 4th Intake (Additional)

Chiang Mai University International College of Digital Innovation is now welcoming applications for International Bachelor Degree Programs for the 2017 academic year.

The program opened for the 4th intake additional admission is:

- Bachelor of Science Program in Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture

1. GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

- 1.1 Applicants must have no record of serious misconduct and agree to strictly follow the rules and regulations of the university.
- 1.2 Applicants must not have a serious contagious disease or any disease that will obstruct their studies.

2. ENGLISH PROFICIENCY QUALIFICATIONS

All Applicants must submit either one of following:

1) All applicants can submit one of the following English Language Certificates with minimum score as listed below:

- o IELTS minimum band score of 5.0 *or*
- o TOEFL minimum score of 500 PBT or 173 CBT or 61 IBT *or*
- o TOEFL ITP Test with a minimum score of 500 PBT from institute/center accredited by Institute of International Education (IIE)
- o SAT1 (critical reading) minimum score of 400.
- o English Placement Test arranged by Chiang Mai University International College of Digital Innovation

2) Applicants who do not have an English Language Certificate, MUST take the English Placement Test arranged by Chiang Mai University International College. The English Placement Test will be held on the same day as the examination for specialized subjects. Test fees must be paid together with the application fee.

3. ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS

3.1 Students who graduated from M.6 in a Thai educational system school are required to meet the minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.25 out of 4.00 in all programs.

3.2 Standard Certifications equivalent to High School in Thai educational system

- 1) Students who graduated from an international school in Thailand and have an equivalency certificate by the Thai Ministry of Education.
- 2) Students who graduated from an overseas institution and have an equivalency certificate and must be accredited by the Ministry of Education.
- 3) Applicants who submit GED must pass all 5 subjects. Each subject must be passed with a minimum score of 410 and a minimum total score of 2,250.
- 4) Applicants who submit IGCSE must have a minimum grade of C in at least 5 subjects.
- 5) Applicants who submit General Certificate in Secondary Education (GCSE) or GCE 'O' level, must have a minimum grade of C in at least 5 subjects. GCE 'A' Level, or 'AS' Level must have a minimum grade of C in at least 3 subjects, with 8 subjects in total.
- 6) Applicants who submit International Baccalaureate (IB) Certificate must have a minimum Grade of 4 in at least 5 non-duplicate subjects *or* International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma.
- 7) Applicants from the Chinese High School System must have the results in their field of study (Arts / Sciences) of at least 4 semesters, with a minimum average score of 60 out of 100 or 90 out of 150 and the full score of each subject must be show in the transcript.
- 8) Applicants from the Myanmar Matriculation System must have a Matriculation Examination Pass Certificate and "O" Level Pass Certificate *or* Matriculation Examination Pass Certificate and transcripts of the first academic year in an undergraduate degree from an acknowledged university.

3.3 Additional Requirements:

- 1) Students who graduated from M.6 in Thai educational system school (as per 3.1) must have Physics and Mathematics with a minimum CGPA of 2.25 out of 4.00 in each subject.
- 2) Student who submit a Standard Certification Equivalency (as per 3.2 except GED) must have Physics and Mathematics in their transcript.

5. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Applicants must complete the online application form and are required to submit clear and readable scanned documents (in A4 size, each file size not over 1 MB) as follows:

- 5.1) A scanned copy of high school graduation certificate/diploma for Matayom Suksa 6, or Grade 12 or Equivalent, Thai or English, or its foreign equivalent. (if not in English, please submit the original document with an official English translation).
- 5.2) A verification letter of current student status (if studying).
- 5.3) A scanned copy of official high school transcript, Thai or English, or its foreign equivalent.
- 5.4) An Official Certificate of English Language ability (If any).
- 5.5) For Thai citizens: A scanned copy of the Thai National I.D. Card.

For non-Thai citizens: A scanned copy of Passport (recommended for a quick visa process) or a scanned copy of the National I.D. card with official English translation.

- 5.6) Health certificate, Thai or English, issued within the last 6 months.
- 5.7) 2x2 inches, full-face, formal photograph taken within the last 6 months (in jpg format).
- 5.8) Personal portfolio in Art, design and handicraft (no more than 15 sheets of A4 size in pdf format, file size not over 16 MB).
- 5.9) Statement of Purpose, stating the interest in the program and intentions in the future (no more than 2 sheets of A4 size in pdf format, file size not over 1 MB).
- 5.10) Reference Letter (no more than 2 sheets of A4 size in pdf format, file size not over 1 MB) from a homeroom teacher, a guidance counselor, or a teacher who can certify the student's portfolio work, as well as student's ability, talents, and development.

Important Remark: If any documents submitted are found to be fraudulent, applicants will be automatically disqualified.

- 3) Candidates are allowed to bring only their I.D. card or passport or national I.D. card with official English translation and writing utensils into the examination room.
- 4) For those who have passed the interview examination, they must report to CMUIC on the designated date and time.

Remark: Candidates must strictly follow the examination rules. If a candidate is found cheating in any way, CMUIC reserves the right to disqualify such candidate in any circumstances.
