Announcement by Chiang Mai University
Application for Admission to the International Undergraduate Programs
For the 2017 Academic Year

Chiang Mai University International College is now welcoming applications for International Bachelor Degree Programs for the 2017 academic year.

The 7 programs opened for admission are:

- Bachelor of Engineer in Mechanical Engineering (1st and 2nd intake)
- Bachelor of Science in Software Engineering (1st and 2nd intake)
- Bachelor of Humanities in Thai as a Foreign Language (1st and 2nd intake)
- Bachelor of Economics (1st and 2nd intake)
- Bachelor of Nursing Science (2nd intake only)
- Bachelor of Science in Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture (2nd intake only)
- Bachelor of Social Science (Social Science ONLY intake)

1. GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

- 1.1 Applicants must have no record of serious misconduct and agree to strictly follow the rules and regulations of the university.
- 1.2 Applicants must not have a serious contagious disease or any disease that will obstruct their studies.
- 1.3 Additional Health Qualifications for Bachelor of Nursing Science Applicants must be in good health, with no illnesses, symptoms, or disabilities which would be an obstacle to study. The following illnesses, symptoms, and disabilities make you ineligible for admission:
 - 1.3.1 Any disability which is an obstacle to study.
 - 1.3.2 Severe psychiatric problems including psychotic disorders, autistic spectrum, mood disorders, severe neurotic disorders, personality disorders such as antisocial personality disorders or borderline personality disorders, or other psychiatric problems which are obstacles to study, practice, and work as a professional nurse.
 - 1.3.3 Any contagious disease in the transmission phase which can be a danger to yourself, the patients, or cause permanent disability which in turn will be an obstacle to study, practice, and work as a professional nurse.
 - 1.3.4 Non-communicable disease or disorders which are an obstacle to study including:
 - 3.4.1 Uncontrolled epilepsy.

- 3.4.2 Severe heart disease which is obstacle to study, practice, and work as a professional nurse.
- 3.4.3 Severe hypertension with permanent complications to any organ.
- 3.4.4 Chronic kidney disease.
- 3.4.5 Substance use disorder.
- 3.4.6 Visual problems including color blindness, or having visual acuity in your good eye of less than 6/12 or 20/40 after correction.
- 3.4.7 Sensory neural hearing loss of a hearing threshold above 40 dB at 500-2,000 Hz.
- 3.4.8 Other diseases or disabilities which the physical examination committee determines as an obstacle to study. The Dean of the Faculty of Nursing may request an expert to help conduct further assessment.

2. ENGLISH PROFICIENCY QUALIFICATIONS

2.1) Applicants who are Non-Native English Speakers or from a country where English is not an official language:

1) Applicants can submit one of the following English Language Certificates with minimum score as listed below:

- o IELTS minimum band score of 5.0 *or*
- o TOEFL minimum score of 500 PBT or 173 CBT or 61 IBT *or*
- o TOEFL ITP Test with a minimum score of 500 PBT from institute/center accredited by Institute of International Education (IIE)

2) Applicants who do not have an English Language Certificate, MUST take the English Placement Test arranged by Chiang Mai University International College. The English Placement Test will be held on the same day as the examination for specialized subjects. Test fees must be paid together with the application fee.

3) For Nursing Science applicants who graduated from an international high school or graduated from a high school in a country where English is an official language and English is the means of instruction do not have to submit an English Language Certificate (e.g. IELTS or TOEFL scores.)

2.2) Applicants who are Native English Speakers and from country where English is an official language:

1) All applicants (except applicants who apply for Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture) will be exempted from the English Placement Test, but will still be required to take entrance examinations as specified by individual faculties/colleges.

2) Applicants who apply for Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture must submit one of following English Language Certificate with minimum score as listed below:

- o IELTS minimum band score of 5.0 *or*
- o TOEFL minimum score of 500 PBT or 173 CBT or 61 IBT *or*
- o TOEFL ITP Test with a minimum score of 500 PBT from institute/center accredited by Institute of International Education (IIE) *or*

- o SAT1 (critical reading) minimum score of 400 *or*
- o English Placement Test arranged by Chiang Mai University International College

3. ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS

3.1 Students who graduated from or are studying in M.6 in a Thai educational system school are required to meet the minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) according to their selected program as follows:

3.2 Standard Certifications equivalent to High School in Thai educational system

- 1) Students who graduated from an international school in Thailand and have an equivalency certificate by the Thai Ministry of Education.
- 2) Students who graduated from an overseas institution and have an equivalency certificate and must be accredited by the Ministry of Education.
- 3) Applicants who submit GED must pass all 5 subjects. Each subject must be passed with a minimum score of 410 and a minimum total score of 2,250.
- 4) Applicants who submit IGCSE must have a minimum grade of C in at least 5 subjects.
- 5) Applicants who submit General Certificate in Secondary Education (GCSE) or GCE 'O' level, must have a minimum grade of C in at least 5 subjects. GCE 'A' Level, or 'AS' Level must have a minimum grade of C in at least 3 subjects, with 8 subjects in total.
- 6) Applicants who submit International Baccalaureate (IB) Certificate must have a minimum Grade of 4 in at least 5 non-duplicate subjects *or* International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma.
- 7) Applicants from the Chinese High School System must have the results of at least 4 semesters, with a minimum score of 60 out of 100 or 90 out of 150.

- 8) Applicants from the Myanmar Matriculation System must have a Matriculation Examination Pass Certificate and “O” Level Pass Certificate *or* Matriculation Examination Pass Certificate and transcripts of the first academic year in an undergraduate degree from an acknowledged university.

3.3 Additional Requirements for those who apply for Mechanical Engineering, Software Engineering, Nursing Science and Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture

- 1) Students who graduated from or are studying in M.6 in Thai educational system school (as per 3.1) who apply for
 - Mechanical Engineering must have Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 out of 4.00 in each subject.
 - Software Engineering must have Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 out of 4.00 in each subject.
 - Nursing Science must have Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and English with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 out of 4.00 in each subject and must also submit National Test score GAT/PAT2 result.
 - Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture must have Physics and Mathematics with a minimum CGPA of 2.25 out of 4.00 in each subject.

- 2) Student who submit a Standard Certification Equivalency (as per 3.2) who apply for
 - Mechanical Engineering must have Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics in their transcript.
 - Software Engineering must have Mathematics and one of following subjects: Physics or Chemistry or Biology in their transcript.
 - Nursing Science must have Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and English in their transcript.
 - Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture must have Physics and Mathematics in their transcript.

Applicants must select one of the following test centers during online application.

- 5.1) Chiang Mai University.
- 5.2) Thai Language and Culture Center at Yunnan Normal University, Kunming, China.
- 5.3) Mae Sot Test center, Tak province, Thailand.

6. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Applicants must complete the online application form and are required to submit clear and readable scanned documents (each file size not over 1 MB) as follows:

- 6.1 A scanned copy of high school graduation certificate/diploma for Matayom Suksa 6, or Grade 12 or Equivalent, Thai or English, or its foreign equivalent. (if not in English, please submit the original document with an official English translation).
- 6.2 A verification letter of current student status (if studying).
- 6.3 A scanned copy of official high school transcript, Thai or English, or its foreign equivalent.
- 6.4 An Official Certificate of English Language ability (If any).
- 6.5 For Thai citizens: A scanned copy of the Thai National I.D. Card.
For non-Thai citizens: A scanned copy of Passport (recommended for a quick visa process) or a scanned copy of the National I.D. card with official English translation.
- 6.6 Health certificate, Thai or English, issued within the last 6 months.
Applicants who apply for Nursing Science must submit Health certificate confirming that he/she must be in good health, with no illnesses, symptoms, or disabilities which would be an obstacle to study (as per 1.3 above).
- 6.7 2x2 inches, full-face, formal photograph taken within the last 6 months (in jpg format).

Applicants who apply for Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture are required to submit the following additional documents:

- 6.8 Personal portfolio in Art, design and handicraft (no more than 15 sheets of A4 size in pdf format, file size not over 16 MB).
- 6.9 Statement of Purpose, stating the interest in the program and intentions in the future (no more than 2 sheets of A4 size in pdf format, file size not over 1 MB).
- 6.10 Reference Letter (no more than 2 sheets of A4 size in pdf format, file size not over 1 MB) from a homeroom teacher, a guidance counselor, or a teacher who can certify the student's portfolio work, as well as student's ability, talents, and development.

Important Remark: If any documents submitted are found to be fraudulent, applicants will be automatically disqualified.

7. APPLICATION FEES AND PAYMENTS

7.1) Application Fee: (Non-refundable): Baht 1,200

7.2) English Placement Test Fee (Non-refundable): Baht 400

7.3) Payment Methods:

Chiang Mai University International College must receive full amount of fee(s) in order for the application to be processed:

- **By Credit Card** Applicant can input credit card details at the end of the online application process (*Note: Processing fee and other related fee will be charged*)
- **By Bank Transfer** Applicant can select Bank Transfer option and the system will generate payment slip payable to “Chiang Mai University International College”

(*Note: Applicant is responsible for other related fees incurred on both sender and receiver ends*)

9. EXAMINATION RULES

- 1) All Candidates must show their Thai I.D. card or passport or national I.D. card with official English translation on examination date. Otherwise, they will not be allowed to take the examination.
- 2) Candidates who arrive at the examination room later than 15 minutes after start time will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
- 3) Candidates are allowed to bring only their I.D. card or passport or national I.D. card with official English translation and writing utensils into the examination room.
- 4) For those who have passed the interview examination, they must report to CMUIC on the designated date and time.

Remark: Candidates must strictly follow the examination rules. If a candidate is found cheating in any way, CMUIC reserves the right to disqualify such candidate in any circumstances.
